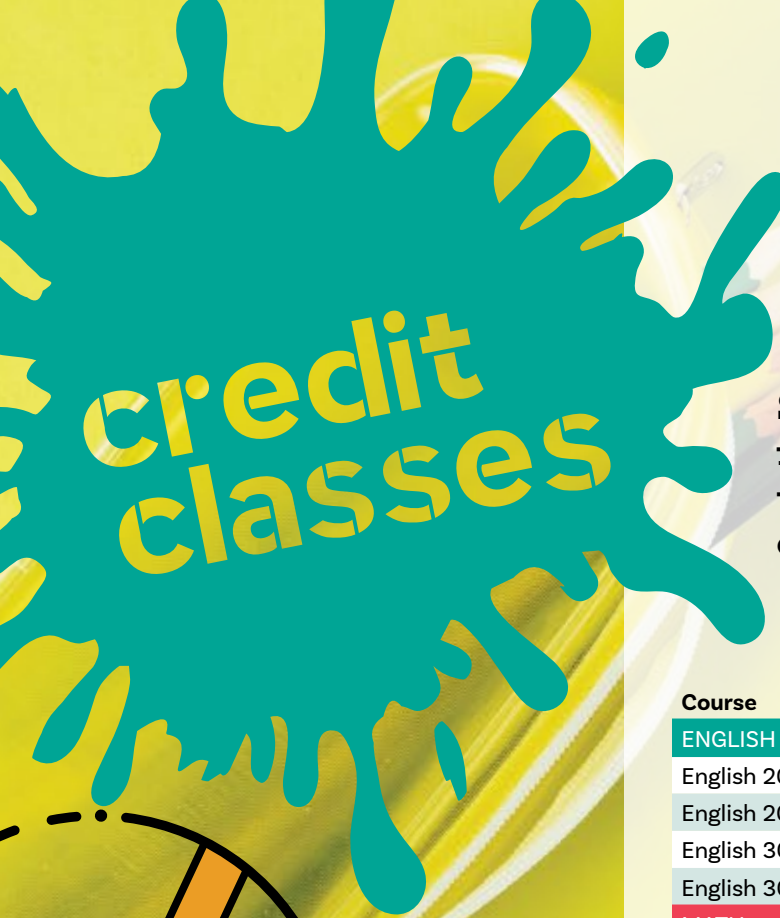

5 Credit Course Fees

Students born after Sept. 1, 1998: \$80 registration deposit –refundable upon successful completion of course

Hands-on Learning

Extreme CALM/PE 10

This program provides activities that will enhance curriculum objectives for PE 10 and CALM with First Aid and outdoor education CTS credits. Staying four nights at Strathcona Wilderness Centre (SWC) during the second week, students will participate in wilderness living skills, canoeing, orienteering, outdoor fitness activities and a variety of team building and leadership development activities. Don't miss out on this hands-on learning experience!

Extreme CTS: Film Production

If you enjoy making short films and want to earn unique high school credits, this is the course for you. Extreme Film Production provides an introduction to the art and history of cinema with a focus on the roles and responsibilities on a film set. Students will create short films for the course as well as their own film portfolio. Experience the filmmaking process from the conception of the idea through to storyboarding, scripting, shooting and editing.

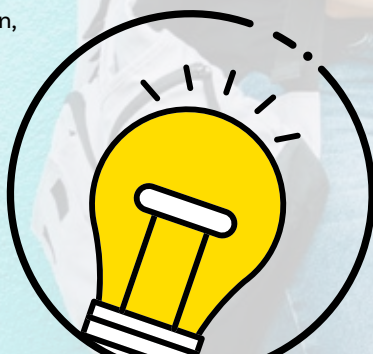
